PROCEDURE FOR ARRIVAL IN INDIA FOR GUESTS FROM ALL COUNTRIES

Before Travel to India

All travelers should

- Submit self-declaration form on the online Air Suvidha portal (<https://www.newdelhiairport.in/airsuvidha/apfo-registration>) before the scheduled travel. The passenger will also have to declare their travel history of last 14 days.
- Upload a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR report. This test should have been conducted within 72 hrs. prior to undertaking the journey.

OR

Certificate of completing full primary vaccination schedule of COVID-19 vaccination (applicable for Countries which have agreement with India on mutual recognition of vaccination certificates). [The list of countries can be found here.](#)

- Each passenger shall also submit a declaration with respect to authenticity of the report and will be liable for criminal prosecution, if found otherwise
- Please ensure that each document is less than 1 MB & is in PDF





On arrival in India

- ▶ Thermal screening would be carried out in respect of all the passengers by the health officials present at the airport. The self-declaration form filled online shall be shown to the airport health staff.
- ▶ **Travelers**, will be allowed to leave the airport **without** any RT PCR test and shall **self-monitor** their health for 14 days' post arrival.
- ▶ A sub-section (**2% of the total flight passengers**) shall undergo post-arrival testing at random at the airport on arrival. These **2%** travellers in each flight shall be identified by the concerned airlines (preferably from different countries).
 - a.** Such travellers shall be escorted by the concerned airlines to testing area on arrival.
 - b.** They will submit the samples and shall be allowed to leave the airport.
 - c.** If such travellers are tested positive, they shall be managed as per laid down standard protocol.





On/Before departure from India

All travellers should

- Get an RTPCR test done 72 - 48 hours prior to departure from India OR as per the guidelines of respective airline / country to which they are departing. The tests can be done on direct payment (approximate cost ranges between USD 12 - 15 per test). Our guide / representative will help the guests in getting the test done. The report will be sent electronically via whatsapp / on e mail ID of the guests within 24 hours of getting the test done.
- ▶ As of now only one airline i.e. Air Canada has made it mandatory to get the test done from their counter at the airport. So guests must report at this counter at least 24 hours prior to travel time to get the test done.

PS:

1) Children under 5 years of age are exempted from both pre- and post-arrival testing. However, if found symptomatic for COVID-19 on arrival or during home quarantine period, they shall undergo testing and treated as per laid down protocol.

2) International travellers arriving through seaports/land ports will also have to undergo the same protocol as above, except that facility for online registration is not available for such passengers currently. Such travellers shall submit the self-declaration form to the concerned authorities of Government of India at seaports/land ports on arrival.

*In case the guests **test positive** for COVID-19 on testing, they will immediately **self-isolate and report to their nearest health facility** or call National helpline number (1075)/ State Helpline Number. Any charges related to change in travel shall be covered by the guest or his / her travel insurance bought by him / her in their home country.*
